



9 To 5 – Non-Principal Roles

All of these roles will be taken by cast members who will also be heavily featured in the ensemble. There are a lot of numbers in this show which will include the ensemble including:

- 9 To 5 – Big Company number introducing the cast. Many solo lines for ensemble cast. Will include dancing.
- Around Here – Big company number in the office. Will include dancing/movement.
- I Just Might – On stage backing vocals for trio.
- Heart To Hart – Big backing vocals
- Dance O Death – Ensemble backing with dance
- Cowgirl's Revenge – Ensemble backing with movement
- Potion Notion – Ensemble backing vocals
- Joy To The Girls – Big company vocal number
- Shine Like The Sun – Big company number with dance
- One Of The Boys – Boys singing and dancing number with Violet
- Always A Woman – Boys singing and dancing number with Franklin Hart Jnr.
- Change It – Big company number in the office with movement
- 9 To 5 (Reprise) – Finale section. Full company with dance

Male Roles

Dwayne – 25-40, Tenor

Husband of Doralee. He appears at a few different points in the show and has some solo singing lines.

Josh – Playing Age 15

Son of Violet. He appears in a couple of scenes and has dialogue. We will cast someone older, but they must be believable when acting his age.

Dick – 25-40

Husband of Judy. He appears in the office to give Judy divorce papers and at the end to beg Judy to come back to him having left her for his secretary.

Bob Enright – 20-40

An employee at the firm who has lots of banter with Frank Hart Jnr. Sucks up a lot to get ahead.

Tinsworthy – Elderly

The head of the company. He appears at the office to see all of the great progress made by the ladies, but is fooled into thinking it is all the work of Frank Hart Jnr.

Detective – Any age

Appears in the hospital investigating a suspicious death. The ladies mistakenly think he is referring to Frank Hart Jnr.

Doctor – Any age

Appears in the hospital helping the detective with their enquiry.

Female Roles

Missy – 30-50

Wife of Franklin Hart Jnr. She appears at the office at inopportune moments almost catching Frank in the act of coming on to Doralee.

Maria – Any age

Finds out that all of the women get paid less than the men at the company and gets fired for sharing salary information. She is rehired when the girls take over.

Kathy – Any age

An employee at the firm who gossips with the others in the filing room!

Margaret – Any age

An employee at the firm with a drinking problem. Strong comedy role appearing in several scenes. At the end she is transformed after going to rehab at the expense of the company.

Candy Striper – 20-25

A young hospital employee who almost catches Violet running off with the dead body on the hospital bed.

New Employee – Any age

Joins the firm and has similar problems with machinery as Judy had at the start of the show.
